Risks

As complex as the task was, with no unanimous consensus on priorities and solutions*, the objectives of the Revision were addressed 'subsequently', and not simultaneously or in parallel, by the IEG formed in August 2018 and re-formed in May 2019 with a new chairmanship and some changes in membership. This situation, if persisted, will result in an uncalculated delay in the prospected timeline.

1. 30 August 2018	Daylong meeting to establish the work plan of the IEG National Library of Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur with some members joining online thru Skype	One daylong meeting following IFLA WLIC 2018 with the Chair of the ISBD RG and the Chair of the recently established ISBD Editorial Group (IEG), some members of the ISBD RG and observers from the National Library of Malaysia. During this meeting, the Terms of reference of the IEG were approved, the methodology, the working plan were established; the venue of the Fall physical meeting of the IEG was decided and the logistics set out. 2. 12 – 14 November 2018	Fall meeting of the IEG Bibliothèque nationale de France ; Dorothy McGarry joining online thru Skype	Fall meeting of the IEG. The group worked out an alignment between ISBD elements and LRM-manifestation, identified the gaps and the inconsistencies at the levels of some sub-elements. Other issues like the completeness and functionality of ISBD punctuation and its role in the emerging and future library system in light of linked data developments, were discussed and explored. The IEG also brainstormed about the possible future structure of the ISBD. The communication plan for the developments and output of the Revision and next steps were discussed and drafted. 3. 22 and 26 May 2019 and 20 June 2019	Online meetings	Skype and Zoom meetings of the new IEG were held to examine the work done by the previous IEG and to set up a new methodology for working together remotely. Critical decisions were made, such as not to lose the granularity of ISBD in achieving the alignment to LRM-Manifestation, and to focus on content issues to make a progress in the Revision. Proposals received by the ISBD RG from the liaisons and communities of users were discussed, documents were centralized and some decisions were made. Reports on ISBD RG activities during 2018/19, IFLA updates, financial update by the Chair of the ISBD Review Group were presented.
	Meeting Room 1	Reports by the RG Liaisons. The development of the ISBD Revision was presented and discussed, including the establishment of the IEG, the Terms of reference of the Revision as endorsed by the Committee on Standards and those of the IEG. A report by the IEG Chair was presented including work plan and developments, discussions, conflicts as well as future work and challenges ahead.
5. 29 August 2019 (13:30 - 16:00)	IFLA WLIC 2019, Athens - Megaron Business Meeting Room 2	The New ISBD RG Chair was elected. During the meeting other agenda items remaining from Business Meeting I were discussed, such as reports by different liaisons of the group and brief review of financial matters. Discussion and evaluation of the IEG presentation in the Committee on Standards Open Session; reporting to the Committee on Standards by the ISBD RG Outgoing Chair. Other matters were briefly reviewed like the status of the ISBD vocabulary as linked data, its readiness for upload on the new IFLA metadata registry. The members of the ISBD RG in the Bibliographic Standards in Linked Data Study Group (Bib-LD SG) were designated. The agenda of the post IFLA WLIC 2019 daylong of 30 August 2019, was presented by the chair of the IEG. The ISBD RG Action Plan 2019 – 2020 discussion was started but not finished. It was decided to discuss it in a Zoom Meeting to be held late September – early October 2019.
6. 30 August 2019 (9:00 – 17:00)	Post WLIC 2019 daylong working meeting of the IEG, Music Library of Greece with some ISBD RG members joining online thru Zoom	The meeting started as a working meeting of the IEG attended by Liaisons from IFLA's Sections, and several members of the ISBD Review Group. It focused mainly on content issues as per the users' communities urgent cataloguing needs. All with considering the urgency of providing an emergency solution for the stakeholders of the Standard, the ISBD RG members observed that focusing on the content only and postponing the future direction of the ISBD would miss the whole point of a Revision that was conceived to bring the standard up-to-date to the technological and bibliographic developments, as its counterparts. From this point on, the meeting continued as an ISBD RG meeting trying to re-adjust the methodology to allow the parallel processing of tasks. Acknowledging the achievements of both IEGs and recognizing the challenges to advance the two objectives simultaneously, it was decided to work in two parallel tracks with clear terms of references and deliverables each, to tackled by two separate Task Forces: Content Update TF and ISBD for Manifestation TF.
