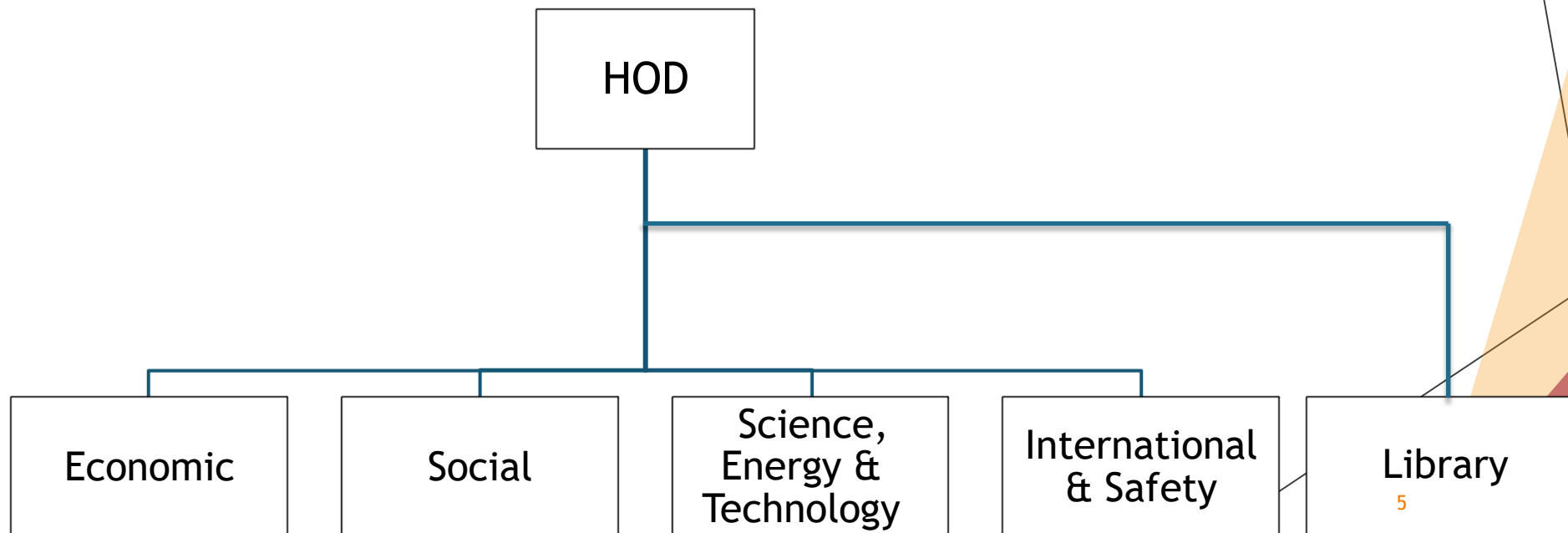
# PARLIAMENTARY RESEARCH SERVICE

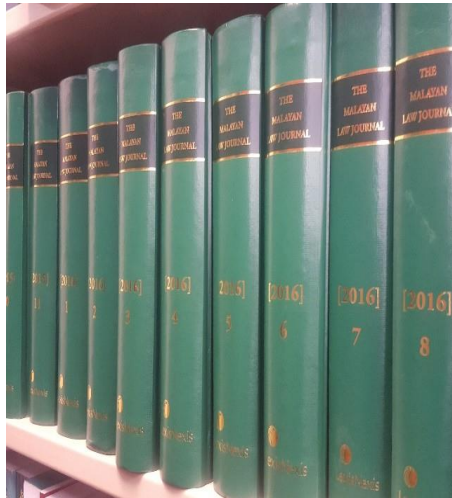

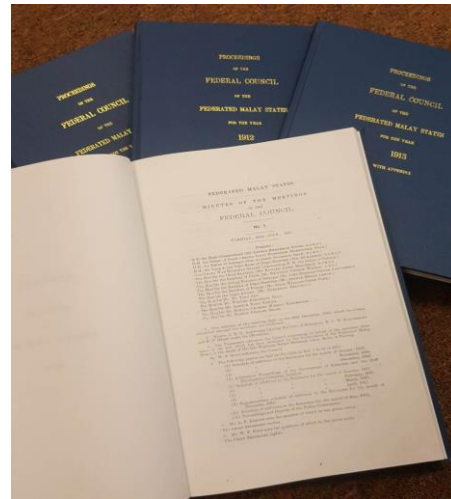

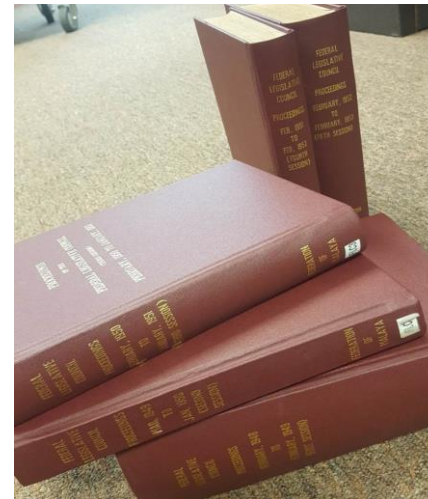
